(b) The provision in former Article 2984, which refused an action for 2 recovery by a loser in a gaming or waging contract in the absence of "fraud, deceit, 3 or swindling," has also been deleted in light of Article 2033, which denies recovery of performance on an absolutely null contract except "in exceptional situations when, 4 5 in the discretion of the court, that recovery would further the interest of justice." 6 (c) The definition of an aleatory contract contained in former Article 2982 has been deleted as unnecessary in light of existing Article 1912. 7 Section 2. Title XIV of Book III of the Civil Code, comprised of Civil Code Articles 8 9 2982 through 2984, is hereby repealed in its entirety.
