Abstract: Repeals certain restrictions on the use of laser or infrared sights on guns while hunting.

<u>Present law</u> restricts the use while hunting of a laser sight or sighting device with a beam of light to people with visual impairments who hold a physically challenged hunter permit. Such people are required to be accompanied by another licensed hunter.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits the use while hunting of an infrared sight, laser sight, or any sighting device with a beam of light to enhance vision at night.

<u>Proposed law</u> repeals both provisions of <u>present law</u>.
