APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT: Appropriates funds for payment of judgment against the Dept. of Transportation and Development in the matter of "Tommy Thompson and Michelle Thompson v. State of Louisiana, et al"

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2012-
3 2013 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Tommy Thompson
4 and Michelle Thompson v. State of Louisiana, through the Department of
5 Transportation and Development, City of Slidell, Parish of St. Tammany and
6 Barriere Construction Company, LLC"; and to provide for related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. The sum of Sixteen Thousand and No/100 (\$16,000.00) Dollars, is hereby
9 appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2012-2013 to
10 be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Tommy Thompson and Michelle
11 Thompson v. State of Louisiana, through the Department of Transportation and
12 Development, City of Slidell, Parish of St. Tammany and Barriere Construction Company,
13 LLC", bearing Number 05-11858 on the docket of the Twenty-Second Judicial District
14 Court, parish of St. Tammany, state of Louisiana.

15 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2012; if vetoed by the governor
16 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
17 2012, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
