JUDGES: Creates an additional judgeship for the $21^{\text {st }}$ Judicial District Court


#### Abstract

AN ACT To amend and reenact R.S. 13:477(21) and 621.21(A) and (E), relative to the Twenty-First Judicial District Court; to create an additional judgeship for the Twenty-First Judicial District Court; to provide for the election and term of the additional judge; to provide for election sections from which judges are elected; to provide for effectiveness; and to provide for related matters.


Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
Section 1. R.S. 13:477(21) and 621.21(A) and (E) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
§477. Judicial districts
There shall be forty-one judicial districts in the state and each district shall be composed as follows:
(21) The parishes of Tangipahoa, Livingston, and St. Helena shall compose the Twenty-First District. The Twenty-First District consists of two election sections. Election Section 1 is composed of Livingston Parish and Precincts 28, 33, $40 \mathrm{~A}, 41,42,44,45 \mathrm{~A}, 45 \mathrm{~B}, 70,70 \mathrm{~A}, 71,72,72 \mathrm{~A}, 73,74,106 \mathrm{~A}, 108,110,112,114$, $\underline{116,117,118,118 \mathrm{~A}, 120,120 \mathrm{~A}, 120 \mathrm{~B}, 121,121 \mathrm{~A}, 122 \mathrm{~A}, 122 \mathrm{~B}, 122 \mathrm{C}, 124,125,}$ $127,133,133 \mathrm{~A}, 137,137 \mathrm{~A}, 137 \mathrm{~B}, 137 \mathrm{C}, 137 \mathrm{D}, 139,141,141 \mathrm{~A}, 143,143 \mathrm{~A}, 145$, 147, 149, 149A, and 151 of Tangipahoa Parish. Election Section 2 is composed of

St. Helena Parish and Precincts 2, 6, 11, 15, 16, 17, 43, 46, 47, 49, 101, 102, 104,
105, 106, 107, 109, 111A, 115B, 119, 123, and 129A of Tangipahoa Parish.
§621.21. Twenty-First Judicial District
A. The Twenty-First Judicial District Court shall have nine ten judges.
E.(1) The Except as provided by Paragraph (2) of this Subsection, the judges and their successors created by this Section shall be elected at large and shall have jurisdiction throughout the district. The judges shall be elected for a six-year term at the congressional election held in 2014 and every sixth year thereafter.
(2)(a) The additional judge added to the court in 2024 shall be elected from election section two as provided by R.S. 13:477(21).
(b) The individual to be elected to the additional judgeship shall be elected as provided by Article V, Section 22 of the Constitution of Louisiana and shall serve a term which begins on January 1, 2025, and which shall expire at the same time as is provided by law for the other judges of the court. Thereafter, the successors to the judge provided for in this Paragraph shall be elected at the same time and in the same manner and shall serve the same term as is provided by law for other judges of the court.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.

Abstract: Creates an additional judgeship for the 21 st Judicial District Court and provides an election section from which the judge is to be elected.

Statistical summaries of proposed law including maps illustrating proposed district boundaries accompany this digest. (Attached to the bill version on the internet.)

Present law provides that the 21st Judicial District Court is comprised of Livingston, St. Helena, and Tangipahoa Parishes. Provides that the 21st Judicial District Court has nine judges, who are elected at large.

Proposed law adds a 10th judge to the 21st Judicial District Court.
Proposed law divides the 21 st Judicial District Court into two election sections and provides that nine judges are assigned to election section one and one judge is assigned to election section two.

Provides that the additional judge added by proposed law shall be elected from election section two and that his initial term begins on Jan. 1, 2025.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
