| 14 | department, and who is under investigation with a view to possible disciplinary |
| 15 | action, demotion, or dismissal. "Fire employee" also includes employees of non- |
| 16 | profit corporations under contract with a fire protection district or other political |
| 17 | subdivision to provide fire protection services, including operators of the fire-alarm |
| 18 | system when such operators are members of the regularly constituted fire |

Abstract: Provides relative to the definition of fire employee for purposes of procedures applicable to the investigation of such an employee.

<u>Present law</u> defines a "fire employee" for purposes of procedures applicable to the investigation of such an employee as anyone employed in a full-time fire department, regardless of his specific duties, who is under investigation.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and additionally defines "fire employee" to include employees of non-profit corporations under contract with a fire protection district or other political subdivision to provide fire protection services.
