In the event the recipient fails to achieve its specific goals and 16 objectives for the use of the funds by the end of the extended term or fails to file its final cost 17 report on or before January 15, 2012, the transferring agency shall demand any unaccounted 18 for funds be returned to the transferring agency.

Section 8. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
effective on the day following such approval.
