2	To amend and reenact R.S. 23:1021(13)(e) and R.S. 33:2004(D), relative to workers'
3	compensation; to provide with respect to municipal and parish fire department
4	employees; to provide with respect to the computation of benefits; and to provide for
5	related matters.

7	Section 1. R.S. 23:1021(13)(e) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

15	(i) For municipal police officers, additional compensation paid by the state
16	pursuant to R.S. 33:2218.4 shall not be included in the calculation and computation
17	of total salary or average weekly wage to the extent such officer continues to receive

19	(ii) For municipal and parish fire department employees, additional
20	compensation paid by the state pursuant to R.S. 33:2004 shall not be included in the

5	Section 2. R.S. 33:2004(D) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

8	D. The additional compensation paid by the state to municipal or parish fire
9	department employees as provided by this Subpart shall be included in the
10	calculation and computation of the total wages paid to the employee in the
11	determination of employer contributions to any retirement system or pension fund
12	of which such employee may be a member as well as in the determination of
13	retirement eligibility and benefits which may accrue to the employee under any
14	retirement system or pension fund, as well as in the determination of any other
15	employee benefits, sick leave, or disability pay to which the employee might be
16	entitled with the exception of workers' compensation benefits paid pursuant to R.S.
17	<u>23:1020.1 et seq</u> .

Abstract: Excludes workers' compensation in the calculation of total salary and average weekly wage for municipal and parish fire department employees.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 23:1021) provides that additional compensation paid by the state to municipal police officers shall not be included in the calculation and computation of total salary or average weekly wage to the extent that the officer receives the additional compensation during his period of disability.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that additional compensation paid by the state to municipal and parish fire department employees shall not be included in the calculation and computation of total salary or average weekly wage to the extent that the officer receives the additional compensation during his period of disability.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 33:2004) provides that additional compensation provided to municipal or parish fire department employees is included in the calculation of total wages in the determination of employer contributions and any benefits to which the employee may be entitled such as retirement benefits, other employee benefits, sick leave, or disability pay.

<u>Proposed law</u> excludes workers' compensation benefits paid from the calculation of total salary or average weekly wage.
