8	and neglected children; and
9	WHEREAS, nearly fourteen thousand children in Louisiana suffer some form of
10	abuse or neglect each year; and
11	WHEREAS, approximately four thousand eight hundred of Louisiana's children are
12	currently unable to live safely with their families and have been placed in foster homes and
13	institutions; and
14	WHEREAS, in 2016, more than three thousand three hundred of Louisiana's children
15	were served by CASA volunteers throughout the state, and over one thousand eight hundred
16	volunteers gave over sixty-five thousand hours of volunteer service to Louisiana's foster
17	children; and
18	WHEREAS, Louisiana's CASA programs and volunteers merit a special measure of
19	commendation for the outstanding work that they do on behalf of the abused and neglected
20	children of Louisiana.
