

SENATE BILL NO. 133

BY SENATOR AMEDEE

Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

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AN ACT

To repeal R.S. 47:9004(B)(4), relative to the board of directors of the Louisiana Lottery Corporation; to provide relative to the duty of certain board members to disclose certain business relationships to the Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs; to remove the requirement to disclose the names of all business or professional clients; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 47:9004(B)(4) is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
