CIVIL SERVICE. Provides relative to classification of personnel from civil service. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))

A JOINT RESOLUTION
Proposing to amend Article X, Section 1 of the Constitution of Louisiana, relative to civil
service employees; to exclude employees of certain sewerage and water boards; and
to specify an election for submission of the proposition to electors and provide a
ballot proposition.
Section 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of the members
elected to each house concurring, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state, for
their approval or rejection in the manner provided by law, a proposal to amend Article X,
Section 1 of the Constitution of Louisiana, to read as follows:
§1. Civil Service Systems
Section 1.(A) State Civil Service. The state civil service is established and
includes all persons holding offices and positions of trust or employment in the
employ of the state, or any instrumentality thereof, and any joint state and federal
agency, joint state and parochial agency, or joint state and municipal agency,
regardless of the source of the funds used to pay for such employment. It shall not
include members of the state police service as provided in Part IV of this Article or
persons holding offices and positions of any municipal board of health or local

	governmental subdivision or persons employed by a sewerage and water board
	in a city having a population in excess of three hundred forty thousand.
	(B) City Civil Service. The city civil service is established and includes all
	persons holding offices and positions of trust or employment in the employ of each
	city having over four hundred thousand population and in every instrumentality
	thereof. Persons employed by a sewerage and water board in a city having a
	population in excess of three hundred forty thousand shall be excluded from the
	city civil service. However, paid firemen and municipal policemen may be excluded
	if a majority of the electors in the affected city voting at an election held for that
	purpose approve their exclusion. The election shall be called by the municipal
	governing authority within one year after the effective date of this constitution.
	However, persons employed by a sewerage and water board in a city having a
	population in excess of three hundred forty thousand shall not be subject to
	such election.
	Section 2. Be it further resolved that this proposed amendment shall be submitted
to t	he electors of the state of Louisiana at the statewide election to be held on October 12,
201	9.
	Section 3. Be it further resolved that on the official ballot to be used at said election
ther	re shall be printed a proposition, upon which the electors of the state shall be permitted
to v	rote YES or NO, to amend the Constitution of Louisiana, which proposition shall read as
foll	ows:
