SENATE BILL NO. 18

BY SENATOR MURRAY

CONFIRMATION. Requires that the appointees to the management board for the proposed academic medical center in New Orleans be confirmed by the Senate and requires financial disclosure. (gov sig)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 40:2004, relative to public hospitals; to provide for confirmation of the  
3 management board of any legal entity formed for the purpose of financing,  
4 constructing, or operating a public hospital or academic medical center in New  
5 Orleans; to provide relative to financial disclosure; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 40:2004 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 **§2004. Public hospital management board; confirmation**

9 **A. Appointees to the management board of any legal entity formed**  
10 **pursuant to R.S. 17:3390, an executed memorandum of understanding, or any**  
11 **other contract or agreement by the Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State**  
12 **University, the state of Louisiana, and the Administrators of the Tulane**  
13 **Educational Fund, for the purpose of financing, constructing, or operating a**  
14 **public hospital or academic medical center in the city of New Orleans shall be**  
15 **subject to confirmation by the Senate prior to being seated on the board of any**  
16 **such legal entity.**

17 **B. The provisions of R.S. 42:1124.2.1 shall be applicable to those entities**

1 **specified in Subsection A of this Section.**

2 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not  
3 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature  
4 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If  
5 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become  
6 effective on the day following such approval.

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#### DIGEST

Murray (SB 18)

Proposed law requires the appointees to the management board of any legal entity formed pursuant to present law (R.S. 17:3390), an executed memorandum of understanding, or any other contract or agreement by the Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State University, the state of Louisiana, and the Administrators of the Tulane Educational Fund, for the purpose of financing, constructing, or operating a public hospital or academic medical center in the city of New Orleans shall be subject to confirmation by the Senate prior to being seated on the board of any such legal entity. Subjects such entities to financial disclosure.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

#### Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

##### Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill.

1. Makes technical correction to provide that the "appointees" to any such board be subject to Senate confirmation.
2. Requires financial disclosure.
