7	Section 1. R.S. 17:3047.1(C) and 3047.4(C)(2) are hereby amended and reenacted
8	and R.S. 17:3047.6(D) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	§3047.1. Advisory council; membership; responsibilities

11	C. By January 1, 2022, and at least once every three years thereafter, the
12	advisory council shall review the workforce priorities of the state and each of its
13	workforce regions and designate qualified programs. The Louisiana Workforce
14	Commission shall convene the advisory council annually for program updates.
15	At least once every three years, the advisory council shall review the workforce
16	priorities of the state and each of its workforce regions and designate qualified
17	programs.

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1	<b>D. Pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act, the Louisiana Office</b>
2	of Student Financial Assistance shall define the period of the year to which a
3	student must attend an educational program in order to qualify under the
4	provisions of this Chapter.
5	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
6	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
7	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
8	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
9	effective on the day following such approval.
