PUBLIC SERVICE COMN. Provides for the redistricting of the Louisiana Public Service Commission. (Item \#5)


#### Abstract

AN ACT To enact R.S. 45:1161.4 and to repeal R.S. 45:1161.5, relative to redistricting; to provide for election districts for the Public Service Commission; to provide for election of commissioners; to provide for effectiveness; and to provide for related matters.


Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
Section 1. R.S. 45:1161.4 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
§1161.4. Public Service Commission districts
A. The state shall be divided into the following five Public Service Commission districts, and one commissioner shall be elected from each district:

B. Each commissioner in office on the effective date of this Section on

December 31, 2022 shall be the commissioner for the district having the same designation as the district from which the commissioner was elected and shall complete the term for which he was elected.

Section 2. R.S. 45:1161.5 is hereby repealed.
Section 3.(A) The precincts referenced in this Act are those precincts identified as Voting Districts (VTDs) in the 2020 Census Redistricting TIGER/Line Shapefiles for the State of Louisiana as validated through the data verification program of the Louisiana House of Representatives and the Louisiana Senate and available on the legislature's website on the effective date of this Section.
(B) When a precinct referenced in this Act has been subdivided by action of the parish governing authority on a nongeographic basis or subdivided by action of the parish governing authority on a geographic basis in accordance with the provisions of R.S. 18:532.1, the enumeration in this Act of the general precinct designation shall include all nongeographic and all geographic subdivisions thereof, however such subdivisions may be designated.
(C) The territorial limits of the districts as provided in this Act shall continue in effect until changed by law regardless of any subsequent change made to the precincts by the parish governing authority.

Section 4.(A)(1) Solely for the purposes of qualifying for election and the election of members of the Public Service Commission from Districts 3 and 4 at the regularly scheduled election for such offices in 2022, the provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall become effective upon signature of this Act by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana.
(2) Solely for the purposes of qualifying for any special election and any special
election of members of the Public Service Commission to fill a vacancy in such an office occurring between the effective date of this Section and January 1, 2023, the provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall become effective upon signature of this Act by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. Any person elected to fill such a vacancy shall be the commissioner for the district as composed in R.S. 45:1161.5 having the same designation as the district from which the commissioner's predecessor was elected until January 1, 2023, after which time the commissioner shall be the commissioner for the district as provided in Section 1 of this Act.
(3) If this Act is vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, the provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval for the purposes established in this Subsection.
(B) For subsequent elections of members of the Public Service Commission and for all other purposes, the provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall become effective on January 1, 2023.
(C) The provisions of Section 2 of this Act shall become effective on January 1, 2023.
(D) The provisions of this Section and Section 3 of this Act shall become effective upon signature of this Act by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If this Act is vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, the provisions of this Section and Section 3 of this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.

Present constitution (Const. Art. IV, §21) creates the PSC consisting of five members elected for overlapping six-year terms from single-member districts.

Proposed law redraws district boundaries for the five PSC districts, effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action for purposes of the 2022 election of commissioners from PSC Districts 3 and 4.

Proposed law retains present districts until January 1, 2023, at which time present law is repealed and proposed districts are effective for all other purposes.

Proposed law specifies that precincts referenced in district descriptions are those precincts identified as Voting Districts (VTDs) in the 2020 Census Redistricting TIGER/Line Shapefiles for the state of La. as validated through the data verification program of the La. legislature. Also specifies that if any such precinct has been subdivided by action of the parish governing authority on a nongeographic basis or subdivided by action of the parish governing authority on a geographic basis in accordance with present law, the enumeration of the general precinct designation shall include all nongeographic and all geographic subdivisions thereof. Further provides that the territorial limits of the districts as enacted shall continue in effect without change regardless of any changes made to the precincts by the parish governing authority.

Population data in the summaries accompanying this digest are derived from 2020 Census Redistricting Data (Public Law 94-171), Summary File for Louisiana. Population data, statistical information, and maps are supplied for purposes of information and analysis and comprise no part of proposed law.
