1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 18:1461.2(A)(2), (3), (5), and (6), relative to election offenses
3 affecting registration and election fraud or forgery; to provide for absentee ballot
4 offenses; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 18:1461.2(A)(2), (3), (5), and (6), are hereby amended and reenacted
7 to read as follows:

8 §1461.2. Election offenses affecting registration and election fraud or forgery;
9 penalties

10 A. No person shall knowingly, willfully, or intentionally:

11 * * *

12 (2) ~~Vote or attempt to vote~~, **attempt to vote, submit an application to vote**
13 **absentee by mail, or attempt to submit an application to vote absentee by mail,**
14 knowing that he is not qualified, or influence or attempt to influence another to vote,
15 **attempt to vote, submit an application to vote absentee by mail, or attempt to**
16 **vote absentee by mail,** knowing such voter to be unqualified or the vote to be
17 fraudulent.

18 (3) Register, vote, **submit an application to vote absentee by mail,** or
19 attempt to register ~~or~~, **vote, or submit an application to vote absentee by mail** in
20 the name of another or in an assumed or fictitious name, or in any manner other than
21 as provided in this Title.

1 (5) Procure or submit voter registration applications or applications to vote
2 absentee by mail that are known by the person to be materially false, fictitious, or
3 fraudulent.

4 (6) Forge, alter, add to, deface, take, destroy, or remove from proper custodial
5 care any book, card, record, voter registration application, application to vote
6 absentee by mail, election return, nomination papers, withdrawals of candidacy,
7 election supplies, election paraphernalia, or any affidavit or other document required
8 or provided for under the provisions of this Title, unless required to be removed by
9 a court of competent jurisdiction for inspection and photostatic copying for the court
10 record.

11 * * *

12 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
13 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
14 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
15 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
16 effective on the day following such approval.
