CONDOLENCES. Expresses condolences upon the death of Isaac G. Joseph.

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To express the sincere condolences of the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana upon the
3 death of Isaac G. Joseph.

4 WHEREAS, it is with deep regret and profound sorrow that the citizens of Louisiana
5 learned of the death of Isaac G. Joseph, on June 3, 2019, at the age of sixty-four; and

6 WHEREAS, Isaac Joseph was Jefferson Parish's first African-American school
7 superintendent, leading the state's largest school district from 2015 to 2018; and

8 WHEREAS, during his tenure in the Jefferson Parish Public School System he also
9 worked as a veteran educator, dean of student services, principal, assistant superintendent
10 of human resources, and executive director of grants and federal programs in which he was
11 responsible for overseeing twenty million dollars in federal grants; and

12 WHEREAS, Isaac Joseph successfully implemented a system policy that gave
13 principals choice in staff selection and developed a skilled workforce in the Jefferson Parish
14 Public School System; and

15 WHEREAS, he was often called a "gentle giant" because he stood over six feet tall
16 and had a magnetic personality that drew kids toward him; many others also consider him
17 a good role model for black educators; and

18 WHEREAS, in 2008, the National Council on Educating Black Children named
