# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year Two Thousand and Nine  
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An Act relative to the treatment of chronic Lyme disease.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 12CC the following  
2 section: -

4 12DD. A physician may prescribe, administer or dispense antibiotic therapy for therapeutic purposes to a  
5 person diagnosed with and having symptoms of Lyme disease of a diagnosis and treatment plan has been  
6 documented in the physician's medical record for that patient and no physician shall be subject to  
7 disciplinary action solely for prescribing, administering or dispensing long-term antibiotic therapy fo9r a  
8 therapeutic purpose for a patient clinically diagnosed with Lyme disease if a diagnoses and treatment plan  
9 has been documented in the physician's medical record for that patient.
