- SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 234A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "not feasible," in line 12, the

- 4 "The court shall provide each juror a physical information card clearly defining the
- 5 charges and legal terms applicable to the trial for which the juror was selected. The court shall
- 6 replace the card upon request."
