An Act relative to sex offenders.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of section 178K of chapter 6 of the General  
2 Laws, as so amended by chapter 38 of the Acts of 2013, is hereby amended by inserting, in the  
3 second sentence, after the word “Investigation.” the following sentences:-

4           No sex offender designated as a level 2 or 3 offenders shall establish a home address or  
5 intended home address or any other living accommodation within 500 feet of the property on  
6 which any public or private school, licensed day care center, or any other child care facility is  
7 located. Nor shall the offender accept employment within 500 feet of the property on which any  
8 public or private school, licensed day care center, or any other child care facility is located.
