Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 57 of said chapter 276, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after the
- 2 second sentence the following sentence:- The bail amount as well as the charges must be
- 3 reported to the Committee for Public Counsel Services so that the data may be tracked to ensure
- 4 proper implementation of the above.
