- SECTION 1: Section 20 of chapter 223 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the following section:
- 3 (X) "Notwithstanding any law or rule to the contrary, any person who is at least 18 years
- 4 old and not a party may serve a summons and complaint for all civil actions pending in District
- 5 Court, Boston Municipal Court, or Superior Court."
