In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act clarifying municipal authority regarding foreclosures.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 127I of chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-
- Nothing in this chapter shall be read to preempt any municipal law requiring a cash
- 4 surety for a property identified as vacant or controlled by a foreclosing entity.
- 5 SECTION 2. Chapter 244, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after section
- 6 40 the following section:-
- 7 Section 41. Except where explicitly denied by the General Laws, municipalities shall
- 8 have authority to enact laws for the purpose of minimizing foreclosures, ensuring the safety and
- 9 security of residents, preventing unnecessary displacement of residents, preventing unnecessary
- 10 post-foreclosure evictions and vacancies, and ensuring the upkeep of vacant properties and those
- in foreclosure.
