An Act relative to the retirement benefits of certain employees of the department of children and families.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 272 , after the word “prisoners;” the  
3 following words:- employees of the Department of Children and Families holding the position  
4 of social worker A/B, C, or D, special investigator A/B, case reviewer, human service assistant,  
5 and human service coordinator or equivalent or successive titles at the Department of Children  
6 and Families who have been employed in such capacities for 10 years or more.
