# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to out-of-district vocational school transportation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8A of chapter 74 of the general laws, as appearing in the 2012

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the section in its entirety and inserting in place

3 thereof the following:-

Section 8A. A town where a person resides who is admitted to a day school in another town under section 7, may, through its school committee, when necessary, provide for the transportation of such person and may provide the transportation for a fee, regardless of where the pupil lives, but a student eligible for a free or reduced lunch under the federal school lunch program, shall not be required to pay a fee; provided, that a school committee may choose to exempt families at other income levels as it may determine; provided further, the no transportation shall be provided for any pupil who resides less than 1 ½ miles from the school

- 11 which he attends. A municipality shall not be required under the provisions of this section to
- 12 provide for the transportation of a person who has completed the twelfth grade of school or the
- 13 equivalent thereto.
