An Act protecting children boarding school buses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7B of chapter 90, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended

2 by inserting after the words "subsequent model year" in line 137 the following clause:-; (19)

3 Every school bus operated on any way shall be outfitted with an operational camera system to

4 detect activities outside of the school bus.
