In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to eligibility to become a firefighter or police officer.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 26 of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the seventh paragraph and inserting in place
- 3 thereof the following paragraph:-
- 4 Notwithstanding any other provisions of this chapter or of any other law, a son or
- 5 daughter of a firefighter who passes the required written and physical examination for the
- 6 appointment of fire alarm operator shall have his or her name placed in the first position on the
- 7 eligible list or, where applicable, in the first position on the reserve roster for appointment to
- 8 such fire or police service or fire alarm service if the death of the firefighter or police officer
- 9 resulted in an award of benefits pursuant to section 100A of chapter 32.

- SECTION 2. The provisions of section twenty-six of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as
- amended by section one, shall apply to all appointments made from eligible lists promulgated by
- 12 the administer after the effective date of the Act.
