**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to recognizing the flag of the Vietnamese National Army as the official flag of the Vietnamese American community in Massachusetts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

2 Section 64. The flag of the Vietnamese American Community of Massachusetts, who fled
3 their beloved nation of Vietnam due to the invasion of communism in 1975, shall be the South
4 Vietnam Heritage Flag as adopted by said nation on June 14, 1949. Such flag is yellow with 3
5 red stripes running horizontally across the center.
