## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to creating a public advancement fund.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 23K of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby

2 amended by inserting after Section 71 the following section:

3 "Section 72. There shall be established and set up on the books of the commonwealth a 4 fund to be known as the Public Advancement Fund. The fund shall be credited with any monies 5 transferred from all registration and renewal fees from online gaming, daily fantasy sports, and 6 online sports betting. Expenditures from the fund shall be subject to appropriation; provided, 7 however that 50 per cent of the funds received shall be appropriated for the purposes of 8 transportation services to supplement, and not offset, any reduction in line item 5911-2000 of 9 the general appropriation act from the previous fiscal year's general appropriation act; and 10 provided further, that the remaining 50 per cent of the funds received shall be appropriated for 11 the purposes of K-12 education and shall be used to supplement, and not offset, any reduction in

- 12 line-item 7061-0008 of the general appropriation act from the previous fiscal year's general
- 13 appropriation act.
