An Act designating a certain bridge in the town of Ashland as the Harold Wadhams Gates memorial bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Bridge number A-14-011 on Fountain street in the town of Ashland shall be designated
- 2 and known as the Harold Wadhams Gates bridge in honor of his service during World War II.
- 3 The Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain suitable bearing this
- 4 designation in compliance with the standards of the department.
