# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for John Taylor Woodward, an employee of the Hampshire County Sheriff's Department.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Hampshire County 2 Sheriff's Department shall establish a sick leave bank for John Taylor Woodward, an employee 3 of the Hampshire County Community Corrections Center. Any employee of the department may 4 voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by 5 John Taylor Woodward. If John Taylor Woodward terminates employment with the department 6 or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be 7 transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for 8 absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave 9 bank as determined by the department.
