Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 5A of chapter 71B of the General Laws, as appearing the 2020
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in subsection (c) the words "and
- 3 transportation".
- 4 SECTION 2: Section 5A of chapter 71B of the General Laws, as appearing the 2020
- 5 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "threshold.", the following:
- 6 Transportation costs shall be reimbursed at 90%.
