Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Chapter 54 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding after section 25 the following section(s):-
- Section 25A. There shall be no school in the public schools that are designated as polling places on the general election day in presidential races.
