Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: Section 28 of chapter 118E of the General Laws, as appearing in th	e 2016

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:—

3 A transfer of resources to a special needs trust that conforms to 42 USC $\frac{1396p}{d}(4)(C)$

4 and established solely for the benefit of a disabled individual of any age shall not be treated as a

5 disposal of resources for less than fair market value.
