In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to designation of polling places.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 54, Section 24 of the General Laws is hereby amended by deleting

2 the following language "...Alcoholic beverages shall not be sold in any portion of a building

3 which is designated as a polling place, during voting hours or while ballots are being

4 counted...", and replacing it with the following language. "...Alcoholic beverages shall not be

5 served or consumed in that portion of a building used as a polling place, during voting hours or

6 while ballots are being counted therein...".

7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
