*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 56 of Chapter 148 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 official edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by striking out the word "three hundred" and inserting in place thereof the
- 3 word: "one thousand."
