Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1.	Section 70I	F of chapter 11	l of the General I	Laws, as appearing	g in the 2016

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3 Notwithstanding the above, if the person's blood has come in contact with another person

4 who may be infected thereby, such tests shall be performed and the result made known to the

5 person who may have been infected despite the inability or refusal of the person to give written

6 consent.
