An Act to exempt certain local housing authority executive directors from anti-spiking provisions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 5 paragraph (2)(f) of chapter 32 of the General Laws as appearing
- 2 in the 2018 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 211, after the word "law" the
- 3 following words:- "from a modification in the salary schedule for a local housing authority
- 4 executive director set in the Department of Housing and Community Development guidelines".
- 5 SECTION 2. The amended section shall apply to anyone retiring after January 1, 2018.
