#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to residency.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 99A of chapter 41 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by striking the section in its entirety and inserting in place thereof the
- 3 following section:-
- 4 Section 99A. Any member of the regular police or fire department and fire alarm division
- 5 of a city or town appointed subsequent to August first, nineteen hundred and seventy eight who
- 6 is not subject to chapter 31 shall reside within fifteen miles of the limits of said city or town. Said
- 7 distance shall be measured from the closest border limits of said city or town in which said
- 8 member is employed to the closest border limits of the city or town in which said member lives;
- 9 provided, however, a city or town may increase the fifteen mile residency limit under a collective
- bargaining agreement negotiated in accordance with chapter 150E.
