*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

3	the following words:- "or an institution offering a graduate or professional degree program".

5	amended by striking out the words "an undergraduate student" and inserting in place thereof the
6	following words:- "a student".
7	SECTION 3. Said paragraph (12) of Section 3 of Chapter 62, as so appearing, is hereby
