An Act making records in the office of the Governor public.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subclause 26, in lines 146 to 158, inclusive, of Section 7 of Chapter 4 of the  
2 General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the  
3 words “section 1 of chapter 32,” in line 157, the following words: “or office of the governor. “

4           SECTION 2. Subclause 26 of Section 7 of Chapter 4 of the General Laws, as appearing  
5 in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby further amended by inserting after “in section 10A of  
6 chapter sixty-six” in line 273, the following sentence: “This section applies to records of the  
7 office of the governor created or received after noon on January 6, 2027.”
