An Act defining "Gold Star families".

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 7 of chapter 4 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the following definitions under the forty third
- 3 definition:-
- 4 "Gold Star parent" shall mean any parent of a member of the armed forces whose death
- 5 occurred as a result of injury sustained, illness, or disease contracted, not due to gross negligence
- 6 or misconduct of the member, during active service.
- 7 "Gold Star spouse" any spouse of a member of the armed forces whose death occurred as
- 8 a result of injury sustained, illness, or disease contracted, not due to gross negligence or
- 9 misconduct of the member, during active service.
