An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Elizabeth O'Brien, an employee of the Department of the Attorney General.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the department of the attorney  
2   general shall establish a sick leave bank for Elizabeth O'Brien, an employee of the department.  
3   Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation  
4   days to the sick leave bank for use by Elizabeth O'Brien. If Elizabeth O'Brien terminates  
5   employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time  
6   in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the department paid leave bank. Sick leave bank  
7   days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the  
8   establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
