An Act authorizing the town of Ashburnham to dispose of certain equipment.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Town of  
2 Ashburnham, acting by and through its Board of Selectmen, may dispose of a 1987 Military  
3 HMMWV by transferring ownership of said vehicle to the Ashburnham Firefighters Association,  
4 which provided the funds for its purchase.

5           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
