## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Linda Kenney, an employee of the Center for Health Information and Analysis.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Center for Health 2 Information And Analysis shall establish a sick leave bank for Linda Kenney, an employee of the 3 agency. Any employee of the agency may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or 4 vacation days to the sick leave bank for the use by Linda Kenney. If Linda Kenney terminates 5 employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time 6 in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank 7 days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the 8 establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
