An Act to amend the general officer designation in the state staff of the militia.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 33 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting, in Section 15(a), in line  
2 3, by adding after the word “general.” the following:

3 "The adjutant general shall be the commanding general of all military forces, organized  
4 militia units, and the military division of the Commonwealth.”

5 And by striking, in Section 15(b), the following: “provided, however, that the adjutant  
6 general shall not personally exercise command of troops.”
