In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to the powers and duties of a regional school district.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 16 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:-
- 3 (s) A regional school district may serve as the fiscal agent when the regional district and
- 4 one or more towns or superintendency union have hired the same superintendent and central
- 5 office staff; provided that the regional district shall enter into a written agreement with the school
- 6 committee or committees concerning the regional district billing the school committee or
- 7 committees for services and payment of personnel.
