**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court  
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to the charter of the town of Provincetown.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 7 of the charter of the town of Provincetown, which is  
2 on file in the office of the Archivist of the Commonwealth as provided in Section 12 of chapter  
3 43B of the general laws, is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:-

4 (a) The chief of police and the director of public works shall reside within 45 driving  
5 miles of the town of Provincetown and shall meet the requirements of this section within six  
6 months of assuming office.

7 (b) The fire chief shall be a resident of Provincetown, Truro or Wellfleet and shall meet  
8 the requirements of this section within six months of assuming office.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage. Or to take any other action  
10 relative thereto.
