An Act relative to the secretary of veterans’ services.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 17a of Chapter 6 is hereby amended by adding after the word  
2 “transportation” the following:- “, the commissioner of veterans services,”

3           SECTION 2. Section 16 of chapter 6A is hereby amended in line 34 by striking out the  
4 words:- (5) the department of veterans’ services, who shall be appointed by the governor , which  
5 shall include the Soldiers’ Home in Massachusetts and the Soldiers’ Home in Holyoke.

6           SECTION 3. Section 4M of Chapter 7 is hereby repealed.
