An Act relative to equitable reimbursement rates for services provided to publicly assisted patients.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 7 of Chapter 118G of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof: The executive office shall develop a plan to index the child and adult dental fee schedule to the seventy fifth percentile of the most current American Dental Association Survey of Dental Fees of General Practitioners by January 1, 2017. The plan, at a minimum, shall include all dental services covered as of January 1, 2009.
