## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act prohibiting unscrupulous medical referral restrictions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 11 of chapter 6D of the General Laws, as so appearing in the 2016
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (e) the following subsection:-
- 3 (f) The commission may suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew a provider organization's
- 4 registration upon a violation of section 187 of chapter 149.
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 187 of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
- 6 amended by inserting after paragraph (4) the following new paragraph:-
- 7 (5) refers a patient to an outside health care facility or provider if: (i) the outside health
- 8 care facility or provider is that other than the health care provider's health care facility or place
- 9 of employment and (ii) the health care provider reasonably believes said referral is in the best
- interest of the patient or at the direct request of the patient.
