In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act regarding the issuance of a warrant where there is an imminent threat.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 276 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section
- 2 24, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, and inserting in place thereof the following
- 3 section:-
- 4 Section 24. Upon a complaint or indictment for any offense, a summons shall issue
- 5 instead of a warrant, unless, in the judgment of the court or justice, there is reason to believe that
- 6 the defendant will not appear upon summons or there is an imminent threat of bodily injury, of
- 7 the commission of a crime, or of flight from the commonwealth by the person against whom
- 8 such complaint is made.
